The Early Childhood Program serves children ages 2 months old through 5 years of age. We offer Monday, Wednesday and Friday classes as well as Tuesday and Thursday classes for infants through age 3. Our 4 year old program operates Monday – Friday. All the children attend the program 9:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. and our programs runs from approximately Labor Day until Memorial Day. The program provides morning snack and all children pack a lunch to eat here at school.



Extra Curricular Activities

We are happy to offer a weekly creative movement class to all ages. Children ages 2-5 will also attend a Wednesday chapel service and music class on Fridays. Three and four year olds begin visiting the Ruth Sheets Adult Day Care Center here at Edenton St. UMC on a weekly basis. The children and older adults do a variety of activities during this time together and both groups benefit from it tremendously.
