

The Plan for Children

So you may be saying...

"I'll be here for the 9:30 start time...but Sunday School for my kids doesn't start until 9:45. How is that going to work??!?!?"

We are so glad you asked! Here's the plan...

Your whole crew piles into the car and heads to The Gathering

Worship begins with a bang at 9:30 (cannon balls optional)

After some singing and other cool stuff, everyone "Meets & Greets"

Kiddos are invited to leave for Sunday School

Guides are in the back wearing snazzy green aprons and holding classroom signs

Kiddos meet in the back right corner under their class sign:

3 yr olds, 4 yr olds, Kindergarten/1st Grade, 2nd-5th Grade

Guides take your little angels to their respective classes on the 3rd floor

At the end of the worship service (10:30) grab another cup of coffee and mingle because kids are in class until 10:45. At 10:40 guides will be available to lead parents to the 3rd floor Sunday School classrooms

3 yr olds (Godly Play): Room 312

4 yr olds (Godly Play): Room 314

Kindergarten (Godly Play): Room 316B

1st Grade (Godly Play): Room 316A

2nd – 5th Grade (Pathways): Room 306

Job Description

1. Grab a snazzy green apron
2. Make yourself a name tag with the labels/markers in your apron
3. Welcome families as they come in
4. Pick up a classroom sign
5. Be stationed at the back right corner with your sign during "Meet & Greet"
6. Welcome the children and do a head count for your group
7. Use the back right stairwell to take the children up to the third floor
8. In the 3rd floor hall ask your group, "Raise your hand if this is your first time."
9. Use the labels in your apron to hand write a name tag for all new children
10. Walk your group to their class
11. Wait at the classroom door and help with name tags
12. Count to be sure each child has entered the room
13. Specifically introduce new children to the teacher
